

THIS IS PHISHING! DON'T GET CAUGHT!

Phishing Clue #1: Phony Sender Email Address
Always make sure that the address matches the sender's name and has an official @company.com email address.

Phishing Clue #2: Impersonal Greeting
Phishing emails will usually have impersonal greetings and misuse them.

Phishing Clue #3: Suspicious Links
Phishing emails often contain suspicious links they want you to click. **DO NOT CLICK!** Hover mouse over link to determine if it is a fake.

Phishing Clue #4: Grammar, Spelling & Writing Errors
Phishing emails will usually contain grammar, spelling or mechanical errors in the message. Notice the lack of space in between **Note:We** in this one.

Phishing Clue #5: Improper Use of Copyright
Phishing emails use the copyright symbol to make it look official, but look out for it being used improperly in Phishing emails.
